What Is God Really Like?

Exodus 34:5-6 Then the LORD came down in a cloud and stood there with him, and he called out his own name, Yahweh. ⁶ The LORD passed in front of Moses, calling out,

"Yahweh! The LORD is a <u>compassionate</u> and <u>gracious</u> God, slow to anger and abounding in faithful love and truth..."

<u>Compassionate</u> = mercy, womb; a tender and fierce passion

This word describes a parent's <u>FEELINGS</u>

Gracious = to bend down in kindness to an inferior, to bestow favor

This word describes a parent's <u>ACTIONS</u>

Luke 15:11-12 To illustrate the point further, Jesus told them this story: A man had two sons. ¹² The younger son told his father, 'I want my share of your estate now before you die.' So his father agreed to divide his wealth between his sons.

Vs. 13-16 A few days later this younger son packed all his belongings and moved to a distant land, and there he wasted all his money in wild living. ¹⁴ About the time his money ran out, a great famine swept over the land, and he began to starve. ¹⁵ He persuaded a local farmer to hire him, and the man sent him into his fields to feed the pigs. ¹⁶ The young man became so hungry that even the pods he was feeding the pigs looked good to him. But no one gave him anything.

Vs. 17-19 When he finally came to his senses, he said to himself, 'At home even the hired servants have food enough to spare, and here I am

dying of hunger! ¹⁸ I will go home to my father and say, "Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, ¹⁹ and I am no longer worthy of being called your son. Please take me on as a hired servant."

Vs. 20-24 "So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion, he ran to his son, embraced him, and kissed him. ²¹ His son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, and I am no longer worthy of being called your son.'

²² "But his father said to the servants, 'Quick! Bring the finest robe in the house and put it on him. Get a ring for his finger and sandals for his feet. ²³ And kill the calf we have been fattening. We must celebrate with a feast, ²⁴ for this son of mine was dead and has now returned to life. He was lost, but now he is found.' So the party began.

- 3. Our father will act to help us, even if he must SACRIFICE
- 4. Loving others is characteristic of God... and it's a characteristic of GOD'S PEOPLE
